ORDINANCE NO. 2014-1

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING STOPPING, PARKING, AND STANDING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON TOWNSHIP ROADS, STREETS AND ALLEYS, PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of the Township of Branch as follows:

SECTION I: Section II of Ordinance No. 85-4 for Branch Township is hereby amended to read as follows:

Except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or to protect the safety of any person or vehicle, or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or official traffic-control device, or except as provided for in Section III, as amended, of this Ordinance, no person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle:

(1) On the North side of Willing Street from Shober Street to State Route 209.

SECTION II: It is hereby authorized and directed that the appropriate signage be erected in accordance with the specifications set forth by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation or this Township.
